- 3. AEA General Conditions Section A27.1 Delay Damages, Delay Damages per day rate should now be changed to \$0.00 for all time periods.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Questions: Resumes are not mentioned in the scoring criteria which led us to believe that they might be
used in the scoring of the "Proposed Project Staff" section. That section is heavily weighted so we don't want
to take chances or make guesses about how they will be used. How with how selection committees will
score these either.

Answer: Project staff pertinent experience should be included in Proposed Project Staff section. Separate full resumes are not to be included.

- 2. Questions: What are the licensing requirements for the mechanical engineer role? Is the professional proposed required to have a Registered Professional Mechanical Engineer-type license (AELM)?
- 3. Answer: Yes, Mechanical Engineer must be a registered Professional Engineering the State of Alaska.
- 4. Questions: It doesn't appear that either Survey or Land Title Search is included in the scope of work, but under "Proposed Project Staff," both of those disciplines are listed in the RFP. Is it necessary to include staff from these disciplines?

Answer: Yes

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
